How would legalisation affect you? Millions testify to the medicinal powers of cannabis and it could replace hundreds of dangerous, profit-driven pharmaceutical products. It will enable further research and investment into the beneficial uses of the plant.. It will help reduce damage through drug misuse, crime and unnecessary pollution.
