The fact that our global economic system operates with finite resources, which pollute and kill thousands annually, means, no mater where you live in the world, from Sheldon to Timbuktu, someone somewhere close to you is suffering because the global economic system says that is the way it has to be.

From the fear of international Islamic terrorism which is an escalation of the Israeli Palestine conflict, to local crime, education, transport and the needs of our senior citizens. We all feel the pinch of minimal funding for much needed, **local**, **sustainable**, **human** and **environmental development**.

Our leaders preach **sustainable development** but the fact still remains **global warming** is quickening and the worlds leaders are actually doing very little in their attempts to reverse it! The resources we use to run the world will run out but not before they have caused the **environmental disasters** humanity needs to avoid.

The folly of our local and world leaders is revealed in their silence for world leaders should have **phased out wood pulp** for paper and **chemical sprayed, cancer causing, soil depleting cotton** for textiles, 80 years ago when a machine was invented to minimise the time spent harvesting hemp biomass, thus making hemp more economically viable for our regions farmers to produce.

They did not do so and 80 years of **rain forest destruction** and **soil erosion** is the end result. Every political party nationally and internationally that has governed since then is guilty in ignorance of condoning this destruction. Oil could have been phased out and replaced with biomass fuel over 60 years ago when Henry Ford created his hemp and sisal car fuelled with hemp biomass fuel. The same may be true today but surely a biomass economy is far better for the future of our children than a fossil fuel driven global economy? The United Nations and our political leaders seem to think biomass is better. So why are they not getting our farmers to grow hemp for fuel, paper and textiles, giving them a much needed annual income?

Latest figures show just over 2.5 thousand acres of farmland grew cannabis hemp in 2002 in the UK. but 32 thousand hectares lay fallow. Cannabis prevents weed growth while also having a root system which enriches the quality of the soil.

Cannabis is a plant which can grow as much as 20 ft high in 3-4 months. Like all plant matter cannabis goes through a process known as **photosynthesis**, it takes carbon dioxide out of the atmosphere and replaces the CO2 with the air we breath.

The biomass grown by our nations farmers would need to be processed by someone and the ideal partners would be the fossil product processors, the paper industry and textile industry. All three industries would have to minimise the processing of fossil products, wood pulp and cotton in favour of biomass hemp. Fossil products, wood pulp, and cotton aid in the destruction of the environment, locally and internationally.

Everyone thinks that cotton is a product which does little harm to the environment but it is sprayed with chemicals to aid growth and to rid the plants of insect pests. The products sprayed on cotton may have caused the deaths of 10's of thousands over the years and also depleted the quality of the soil thus turning places like the **Punjab**, once the **breadbasket** of India slowly into **desert land**. Yet we as consumers are forced to buy cotton products or synthetics made out of chemicals because we have no other alternative, yet cannabis hemp can be made into cloths far more durable and longer lasting than synthetics or cotton.

#### What the major parties promise.

**Labour** promise that the majority of our nations power will come from biomass by the year 2050. The predicted **global warming** events might well have killed many Sheldon residents by 2050 for according to those predictions things are going to get far worse and thanks to our use of these polluting products do not stand a chance of getting any better. If you vote Labour you vote for an unsustainable future for your children no matter what they promise with their lips.
