My opponents will tell you that cannabis causes crime but apart from using cannabis I break no other law - There is no evidence to back this claim up. My opponents have only one thing to offer - A failed policy.

I opened two cannabis cafes in Worthing as a social experiment. I learnt the trade in Holland where the Dutch "coffeeshop" system has worked very well for over 30 years. In Holland society hasn't folded and the trains run on time.

The police raided my cafes many times - Let's look at the evidence produced. In all the raids there was never anyone under 18 found on the premises. Our strict policy of no under 18's meant that we were protecting the young. In all the raids there was never any hard drugs found on the premises. This meant that we had successfully separated cannabis from hard drugs. In all the raids there was never any stolen property found on the premises. There is no evidence to back up the claim that cannabis causes crime. The only time the police ever visited my cafes was to raid them. They were never called in to sort out trouble which is a boast that most pubs can't make.

Prohibition will continue to leave the cannabis trade in the hands of criminals where there is no control, no safeguards and no protection for the young. In a modern society we need modern solutions not tried and failed policies.
