

WHY VOTE LCA

A vote for the LCA and me would send a powerful message to the government that we do not want valuable police time and our money spent on pursuing sick and elderly members of our society for using cannabis to ease their suffering. Look at the case of 'the cannabis gran' just given 6 months imprisonment suspended for 2 years and fines totalling in excess of £1000- plus the cost of police forensics and cell and court time. I myself was prosecuted for growing cannabis when the present leader of the conservatives Michael Howard was Home secretary. I was sick from caissons disease from commercial diving and was in a wheelchair. I was growing plants for my own medicinal use with no dealing or any other intention. I was put on remand in a bail hostel disabled suite, banned from Anglesey and eventually sentenced to 2 years imprisonment. I served the sentence in solitary with no recreational facilities to suit my disability on the medical wing of Walton prison. Despite protesting and appealing I was locked into a system where they did not have a clue how to deal with me, so they did nothing. Shame on them all, it cost the taxpayer - YOU - over £250,000 to do this to me. So if you use cannabis or a member of your family uses or you see someone using it and you do not report it you too can be treated like Gran and I. There is no statute of limitations for such offences so you can be arrested at any time and be criminalised. It is estimated that over 25% of the population have tried cannabis and the figure is higher for the people who have seen it being used. Over 50% of our children risk criminalisation.

MORE REASONS TO VOTE LCA

At the moment it is illegal to utilise any part of the cannabis plant why is this you wonder? We all know sails and rope were made from hemp cannabis. There used to be a law in this country making it illegal not to grow it! It was used for fuel, fibre, food [gruel], and medicine. In the early 1900's, when Rudolf Diesel invented his engine, it was to be run on vegetable oil. Henry Ford's Model T was originally designed to run on hemp fuel and its body parts were made from plastics derived from cellulose from the plant. At the time, world power was in the hands of the farmer. Using mineral oil and synthetics derived from oil wrestled power from the farmers and gave it to the oil barons instead. Starts to make sense now, why wait for harvest and all that processing when you can use fuel oil ready from the ground, no need for expensive workers. More profits for fewer people.

In North Wales to grow hemp cannabis one needs a licence, inspection, and are restricted to using seed sourced from overseas, mainly France. Legalising would free this draconian, unnecessary regulation that the farmers are burdened with when they seek to change their practices. The processes and markets are there for cannabis products: bio-fuels, fabrics, fibre, and food. There's a great opportunity for us all to become involved in producing world-beating products using the hemp plant. 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CANNABIS IT'S A CRIME!

With no recorded deaths and no hard evidence of permanent harm from the use of cannabis, it is strange that tobacco and alcohol are not treated more severely than cannabis – but they are legal! Over 60% of crime is drug-related. 80% of arrests are for cannabis alone. Legalisation would free-up 80% of the money spent the polices drug-busting strategy. This can be achieved through over-18's-style cafes and members clubs, maintained and regulated.

Hi I am TIM EVANS, your Ynys Mon/Conway candidate for the Legalise Cannabis Alliance party. I am 48 years old and have 4 grandchildren aged 1-15 years who are born and brought up and live on Anglesey and are welsh speaking. I came here with my father, a RAF officer stationed at valley in 1963, and my mother who taught all the village kids puppetry in her group Stage Gang and Llanfaelog puppets.

I attended Rhosneigr primary, Holyhead Seleg Secondary, Bangor Tech, Llangefni Pencraig [now Coleg Menai] school to university entrance standards in sciences, art and psychology. My grandfather developed the rindepest vaccine, working as a government vet in Nigeria, which saved most of Africa's cattle: he was awarded the OBE. My grandmother was torpedoed in convoys twice and suffered from posttraumatic stress disorder and Parkinson's disease later in life. I first worked as an algologist for Seed Oysters UK Ltd [now the Sea Zoo Brynciencin] and went on to be a deep-sea diver working on the Piper Alpha oil rig [the one that blew up] for over 5 years. I suffered from caissons disease as a result of diving and have had 15 bone breaks and a hip replacement. I have spent 2 years in a wheelchair and 10 years getting out of it. I now breed and show Rhodesian Ridgeback Dogs to a high standard.

Last year I was the company secretary of an LTD I.T. company locally and the treasurer of brUNIMA the oldest and most respected puppetry organization in the World, half sponsored by UNICEF. I have worked internationally with puppets around the world I was in Kenya/ Nairobi 2002 edupuppets, teaching aids workers to get the AIDs message over, as puppetry transcends all cultural and language barriers and of course making the street kids smile for at least once in their life with flamboyant punch and Judy antics.

I was brought up with a highly developed sense of fair play '**chware teg**' and believe injustice is the biggest evil in our society.

It is with this principled upbringing that I could never understand why the laws on the use of cannabis ever came to be. I then looked long and hard into the motivations and fears surrounding the issue and the more I looked I saw corruption and sleaze fuelled by prohibition. Into the bad state of affairs we have today.
